

## SAMPLE LOGIC MODEL

Improve existing mentoring initiatives in the community by enhancing the recruitment, training, and support of volunteer mentors.

Inputs Activities Outputs Outcomes

- staff and staff time
- volunteers and volunteer time
- facilities
- equipment and supplies
- money

- training sessions providing the skills and tools to become a successful mentor
- forum to establish a network of peers and community supports for mentors
- number of mentors trained
- percentage of participants that sign up as mentors
- increase in mentoring matches made in a year
- percentage of attendees that indicate on their event evaluation form that they feel prepared and confident to be a mentor

- participants are excited and ready to make a difference in their community
- trained mentors make a positive difference in their community utilizing the skills and support they received at the training event
- lasting relationships established between mentors and BBBS, ultimately increasing the length of time mentors remain involved with the program
